The Ontario Camp of the Deaf is located on 400 acres between two lakes, south of Parry Sound, approximately 3 hours drive from Toronto.

This camp is a fantastic opportunity for adult signers of beginner to advanced levels to participate in a total American Sign Language environment. Deaf Instructors will make class times and activities an exciting and fun learning experience! Enjoy a total immersion experience following our "NO VOICE" rule! This is a best way to learn and increase your ASL skills. From the time you arrive at the camp, all conversation must be in ASL until you leave the camp. In class, activities and at meal times, Instructors will teach you the signs you need to communicate (there will be notepads to write if needed). Through events and participant interaction, you will experience ASL in motion! Enjoy an amazing time!

SCHEDULE:

Check In: Arrive at the camp AFTER supper between 5:30 pm and 7:30 pm on Sunday, August 4th. The orientation is at 8:00 pm sharp.

Location: Main Building – someone will guide you to your dorm and parking.

Preparation: Please eat dinner before arriving on Sunday, August 4th.

Check Out: Saturday, August 10th between 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm. Camp details will be sent via email five days before camp.

LODGING

We provide lodging in a dorm-style setting. However, please note that you will need to provide your own bedding (i.e. sleeping bag or single sheet and blanket), pillow, towels and personal necessities.

PAYMENT METHODS

Registration: Complete the registration form online.

Payment: Pay the registration fee securely using PayPal and click "submit" on the registration form.

PayPal: You will be redirected to PayPal for payment. Log in with your PayPal account or choose to pay without an account.

EARLY BIRD FEE:

Our Early Bird Registration fee is \$650, covering all meals, accommodations and classes. The early bird special deadline ends on Friday, July 5, 2024 or before. Register online with a non-refundable deposit of \$100. The balance of the payment is due on Monday, July 22, 2024 or before. ****SAVE \$150****

REGULAR FEE:

Our Regular Registration fee is \$800, which includes all meals, accommodations and classes. A non-refundable Deposit of \$250 must be included when you register online. The balance of the payment is due on Monday, July 22, 2024 or before.





TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to the camp is your responsibility.

If you wish, you may still drive yourself to the camp or set up carpools on your own but we will not be able to assist with arrangements.

On Saturday, it will be the end of the week festivities with a special closing breakfast and wrap-up!
